## Terms & Conditions:

### International Tours – Reservation, Change & Cancellation, Travel Documents & Visas, and Travel Reminders

1. Reservation: When making your reservation, you must provide a copy of your current passport (with minimum 6-month validity). Name correction will be subject to change fee and/or penalty.
2. Payment: A deposit of US\$1000 per person is required upon confirmation of your reservation and remaining balance must be paid at least 90 days before tour departure. Otherwise, your reservation will be automatically canceled without prior notice and the deposit paid will be forfeited. Valid promotion code must be entered when booking in order to enjoy the relevant discount. Any retroactive claim will not be accepted.
3. Booking Confirmation: Upon completion of your online reservation, the system will automatically send the relevant booking confirmation to your email address, and our Reservation Specialists will contact you shortly.
4. Cancellation or Change Policy
  - a. Cancellation or change request must be submitted to our Tour Department in writing either by fax or email. Request by phone is not acceptable.
  - b. The following processing fee will be charged based on the numbers of days prior to tour departure upon our receipt of your request.

<b>D2</b>	<b>Arrival at Beijing</b> Upon landing at Beijing Capital International Airport, you'll be greeted with a warm welcome and transferred straight to your hotel. <b>D3</b>	<b>Beijing → Tiananmen Square → Forbidden City (B: Hotel)</b> <b>Forbidden City:</b> Enter via Meridian Gate; explore Hall of Supreme Harmony & Hall of Central Harmony; admire imperial architecture (Note: Tickets are pre-reserved in advance; if unavailable, visit the Imperial Ancestral Temple instead (no extra cost)) <b>Beijing Panda, Hutong Life &amp; Hot Pot Tour (Compulsory Option):</b> Visit the Panda House at Beijing Zoo for a close-up look at giant pandas, then explore the charming hutongs of Shichahai, known for their lakes, historic lanes, and local shops. Enjoy a warm visit to a local family home for a glimpse into traditional Beijing life, and end the day with an authentic Beijing hot pot dinner.	
<b>D4</b>	<b>Beijing → The Great Wall → Jade Museum (B: Hotel)</b> Afternoon, visit a Jade Museum to learn about jade craftsmanship and cultural significance <b>Summer Palace &amp; Peking Duck (Compulsory Option):</b> Explore the elegant Summer Palace, strolling along the colourful Long Corridor, visiting the Tower of Buddhist Incense, and admiring scenic Kunming Lake and the Marble Boat. Conclude the experience with a classic Beijing Peking Duck dinner at a renowned traditional restaurant.	
<b>D5</b>	<b>Beijing  Wuxi (B: Hotel)</b> Visit the <b>Temple of Heaven (Compulsory Option)</b> in the morning, strolling its serene parklands where locals practice tai chi and exploring the grand ceremonial halls once used by emperors.	
<b>D6</b>	<b>Wuxi → Suzhou (B: Hotel)</b> Visit the tranquil Brilliance of Lake Lihu, stroll its classical gardens and elegant bridges, then explore a freshwater pearl farm and a Purple Sand Art Gallery showcasing traditional Yixing teapots. Continue to <b>Suzhou Grand Canal Cruise (Compulsory Option)</b> , the "Venice of the East," and enjoy a scenic Grand Canal cruise, sampling local specialties while soaking in the timeless beauty of Jiangnan. <b>D7</b>	<b>Suzhou → Hangzhou (B: Hotel)</b> Start the day at the Linger Garden, a UNESCO World Heritage site, exploring its pavilions, rock formations, and winding corridors. Visit the Suzhou Silk Factory to see traditional silk production, then travel to Hangzhou, praised by Marco Polo as "the most beautiful and magnificent" city. In the evening, enjoy the <b>Romantic Show of Song Cheng (Compulsory Option)</b> , a spectacular performance bringing Hangzhou's legends, history, and famous tales to life through music, choreography, and stunning visual effects.
