It is a gigantic wooden construction constituting of rosewood and teakwood in a delicate craftsmanship with wedges and latches. It fully presents the glorious style of Bangkok Dynasty.

PASSPORTS & VISA

RESERVATION AND PAYMENT

A deposit of US\$500 per person is required to reserve space on the tour. The balance is due 45 days prior to departure. Only cash, bank draft or certified cheque will be accepted for any payment made within 30 days of tour departure, personal cheque will not be accepted.

CANCELLATIONS PENALTIES

Notice of cancellation must be made in writing to Gold-Gold Travel and the following scale of cancellation fees will be applied.

- Over 45 days prior to departure, US\$500 per person.
- From 31 44 days prior to departure, US\$900 per person.
- From 21 30 days prior to departure, 75% of total price.
- Within 20 Working days prior to departure or withdrawal from a tour, will regard forfeiting the tour on own, no tour fee will be refunded.
