**DAY 1: Departure for DENMARK****DAY 2: COPENHAGEN**

Upon arrival, visit Frederiksborg Castle (Incl. in Compulsory Prepaid Item), a magnificent Renaissance masterpiece showcasing royal treasures and historical artifacts. Continue to the city center to see the Little Mermaid, Gefion Fountain, and the Amalienborg Palace (Photo stop outside), and Nyhavn.

Overnight: AC Hotel Bella Sky Copenhagen or similar

**DAY 3: COPENHAGEN – OSLO (BY CRUISE)****B/D**

After breakfast, visit the Hans Christian Andersen Statue, City Hall Square, and stroll along the bustling Strøget. In the afternoon, transfer to the port and board a cruise to Oslo. Enjoy a buffet dinner on board and explore the ship's duty-free shops, restaurants, and bars for a relaxing evening at sea.

Overnight: DFDS cruise seaview cabin or similar

**DAY 4: OSLO****B**

After breakfast, disembark and begin your city tour of Oslo. Visit the world-famous Vigeland Sculpture Park, featuring over 200 sculptures depicting the human experience. Then see the exterior of the Opera House, Royal Palace, City Hall, National Theatre, and Nobel Peace Center.

Overnight: Radisson Blu Alna or similar

**DAY 5: OSLO – HARDANGERFJORD – VOSS****B**

After breakfast, drive to Hardangerfjord, often referred to as the "Queen of the Fjords." Shaped by ancient glaciers, this spectacular fjord is framed by towering mountains, cascading waterfalls, and verdant valleys. Cross the Hardanger Bridge, the longest suspension bridge in Northern Europe, and take in the stunning panoramic scenery.

Overnight: Scandic Voss or similar

**DAY 6: VOSS – FLAM – SOGNEFJORDEN – BERGEN****B**

In the morning, take a train to Myrdal, then board the famous Flåm Railway (Incl. in Compulsory Prepaid Item). This breathtaking scenic journey winds through steep valleys, thundering waterfalls, and majestic mountain landscapes. Upon arrival in Flåm, board a Fjord Cruise (Incl. in Compulsory Prepaid Item). Cruising along the Sognefjord—Norway's longest and deepest fjord, often hailed as "the King of the Fjords"—offers unforgettable views of dramatic cliffs and pristine nature.

Continue to Bergen and explore the Bryggen Wharf, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Take the funicular up Mount Fløyen for panoramic views of the city and surrounding landscapes. End the day at the Fish Market, where you can sample fresh local seafood.

Overnight: Scandic Kokstad or similar

**DAY 7: BERGEN – STOCKHOLM (BY FLIGHT)****B**

After breakfast, fly to Stockholm. Visit Drottningholm Palace (Incl. in Compulsory Prepaid Item), Sweden's best-preserved royal castle, built in the 1600s and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, inspired by Versailles. Stroll through the Old Town to admire its medieval charm and view the exterior of the Royal Palace.

Overnight: Scandic Alvik or similar

**DAY 8: STOCKHOLM – HELSINKI (BY CRUISE)****B/D**

After breakfast, visit Stockholm City Hall (Incl. in Compulsory Prepaid Item), where the annual Nobel Prize banquet is held in the Blue Hall, followed by dancing in the Golden Hall. (Note: The City Hall is an official government building and may close unexpectedly due to official events. Alternative arrangements will be made if necessary.) Next, visit the Vasa Museum (Incl. in Compulsory Prepaid Item) to see the world's best-preserved 17th-century warship.

In the afternoon, transfer to the port and board a cruise to Helsinki. Enjoy a buffet dinner on board and explore the ship's duty-free shops, restaurants, and bars for a relaxing evening at sea.

Overnight: Tallink Silja seaview cabin or similar

**DAY 9: HELSINKI****B**

After breakfast, disembark and begin the city tour of Helsinki. See the exterior of Helsinki Cathedral, Uspenski Cathedral, Temppeliaukio Rock Church, and Sibelius Park. Visit the Market Square to experience local Finnish culture and products.

Overnight: Scandic Grand Marina or similar

**DAY 10: HELSINKI – REYKJAVÍK (BY FLIGHT)****B/D**

After breakfast, fly to Reykjavík, the capital of Iceland. Upon arrival, enjoy a city tour including the exterior of Hallgrímskirkja Church, then visit the world-famous Blue Lagoon. The warm, mineral-rich milky-blue water is heated by underground lava flows. You may enjoy a soak, sauna, spa, or personal treatments to relax (at your own expense).

Overnight: Grand Hotel Reykjavík by Islands Hotel or similar (2 nights)

**DAY 11: REYKJAVÍK****B**

After breakfast, embark on the Golden Circle Tour:

Geysir Hot Springs – erupting every few minutes, shooting water columns up to 12 meters high, offering a spectacular display of geothermal power. Gullfoss Waterfall – Iceland's second largest and one of its most beautiful waterfalls. Its golden hue at sunset earned it the name "Golden Falls." Þingvellir National Park – This UNESCO World Heritage site is historically significant as the location of Iceland's ancient parliament and is geologically unique as it sits in a rift valley between the North American and Eurasian tectonic plates
