DAY 1 Beijing Arrival (PEK or PKX)

Welcome to Beijing! Upon arrival at Beijing Airport, you will be escorted to your hotel.

DAY 2 Beijing – Tiananmen Square

DAY 3 Jade Carving Workshop and the Great Wall

On the way, you'll stop at one of China's premier Jade Exhibitions to discover the story behind this celebrated stone. Once back in Beijing, the evening is yours to relax or join an optional activity.

Optional tour: Summer Palace with meal(\$ 90.00/pp)

The Summer Palace is a UNESCO-listed masterpiece of Chinese landscape garden design. It perfectly harmonizes breathtaking architecture with natural scenery. Be sure to admire the iconic Long Corridor with its intricately painted scenes, gaze across the serene **Kunming Lake**, and see the famed **Marble Boat** that never sets sail. Your visit will be complemented by an exquisite Chinese meal.

DAY 4 Beijing to Suzhou by high-speed train

Meals: Breakfast

Your day begins with a visit to a **Traditional Chinese Health Center** for an introduction to the world of traditional Chinese medicine. Your bullet train may be scheduled to arrive at Wuxi East Station which is close to Suzhou.

DAY 5 Suzhou to Wuxi by coach

DAY 6 Wuxi to Hangzhou by coach

It transports you through from the imperial grandeur of the Southern Song Dynasty to the beloved legends like "The Butterfly Lovers" etc.

This evening attends the Captain's Welcome Banquet and enjoy the evening entertainment with a Minorities and Dynasty Costumes Show.

DAY 13 Yangtze River

Today you will enjoy shore excursion to **Shennong Stream**. You will leave your cruise ship and board smaller vessels to sail through the narrower and breathtaking Lesser Three Gorges region, lined by sheer cliffs and mountains. Along the river you may see the ancient plank road and the Hanging Coffins. You will then return to the ship and continue sailing into **Wu Gorge**. You may also want to visit Three Gorges Apex (optional tour, it is free). It Offer breathtaking panoramic views of the majestic Yangtze River. Then sail through **Qutang Gorge**, the shortest (5 miles), narrowest (500 feet), and most dramatic gorge.

Optional tour: White Emperor City or Peak of the Three Gorges (\$90/pp)

This ancient fortress, often shrouded in mist and legend, offers a mesmerizing journey through China's storied past. Renowned as the "City of Poems".

DAY 14 Yangtze River

Then continue to pass through the mountains of Eastern Chongqing. Tonight enjoy the farewell dinner and pack your bags in preparation for disembarking tomorrow.
