The Queen's Head rock is the symbolic scene in the park as well as the name card of the tourism industry of Taiwan. Visit Jinshan Old Street, which is an integration of ways of entertaining. Visit Shifen Waterfall. It is the largest curtain like waterfall with the height of 20 meters and width of 40 meters. Drive to the Shifen Station and fly the sky lantern (lantern fee on your own expense). Visit Jiufen city. You could enjoy local delicacies like taro dumpling, beef noodle, and fish ball. Lunch and dinner are on your own arrangement.

Visit Xinbeitou Historic Station, Beitou Hot Spring Museum, Plum Garden, Beitou Geothermal Valley (Hell Valley), Taipei 101 building (will not go to the top), and Xinyi Shopping block.

Lunch is on your own arrangement. Dinner will be arranged in the famous restaurant Din Tai Fung



PASSPORTS & VISA

Passengers are responsible for all visas, entry, health and other requirements and documents required by law, regulations, orders and/or requirements of countries visiting. The operator and/or its agents are not responsible for passport, visa requirements, entry, health, or other requirement of the countries visited or for any loss sustained by passengers for failing to comply with laws, regulations, order and/or requirements of countries visited.

RESERVATION AND PAYMENT

A deposit of US\$500 per person is required to reserve space on the tour. The balance is due 45 days prior to departure. We reserved the right to cancel the reservation should payments not be received within the above specified periods, and all payment previously made will not be refunded under this circumstance. Only cash, bank draft or certified cheque will be accepted for any payment made within 30 days of tour departure, personal cheque will not be accepted.

CANCELLATIONS PENALTIES

Notice of cancellation must be made in writing to Gold-Gold Travel and the following scale of cancellation fees will be applied.

- Over 45 days prior to departure, US\$500 per person.
- From 31 44 days prior to departure, US\$850 per person.
- Within 30 Working days prior to departure or withdrawal from a tour, will regard forfeiting the tour on own, no tour fee will be refunded.
