PASSPORTS & VISA

Passengers are responsible for all visas, entry, health and other requirements and documents required by law, regulations, orders and/or requirements of countries visiting. RESERVATION AND PAYMENT

A deposit of US\$500 per person is required to reserve space on the tour. The balance is due 45 days prior to departure. We reserved the right to cancel the reservation should payments not be received within the above specified periods, and all payment previously made will not be refunded under this circumstance. Only cash, bank draft or certified cheque will be accepted for any payment made within 30 days of tour departure, personal cheque will not be accepted.

CANCELLATIONS PENALTIES

Notice of cancellation must be made in writing to Gold-Gold Travel and the following scale of cancellation fees will be applied.

- Over 45 days prior to departure, US\$500 per person.
- From 31 - 44 days prior to departure, US\$800 per person.
- Within 30 Working days prior to departure or withdrawal from a tour, will regard forfeiting the tour on own, no tour fee will be refunded.
